The Te Fono mobile dental unit made a quick pit stop for a WOF and touch-up before hitting the road again. Built by our team earlier this year, the unit is now travelling across Tāmaki Makaurau, helping The Fono deliver essential dental care directly to communities. Inside, it's a compact clinic with everything from a dental chair and steriliser to a welcoming waiting area, removing barriers and bringing better oral health to families, one smile at a time.



Meanwhile, the print shop team celebrated a major workspace upgrade with the arrival of a brand-new application table. Installation took muscle, precision, and teamwork, but it was worth every step. With built-in lighting and a larger surface area, it's already improving accuracy, speeding up processes, and making the day-to-day a whole lot smoother.

At Foreman Road, the team wrapped up a busy month of trailer and truck deck builds. Cooltrans units, signature trailers, small delivery builds for Woolworths, and decks for Tegel and Krisham all moved through the line, showcasing the variety and scale of what we do. A huge shoutout to our steelwork team, punching out over 500 components each month, and to everyone behind the scenes who keeps the momentum going. Your hard work doesn't go unnoticed.

And looking ahead, there's even more to be excited about. The Voyager production line is officially underway, marking the beginning of an entirely new build process and layout. This project is a big step forward, not just in what we make, but in how we make it. It's a huge team effort involving planning, development, and smart design, and we can't wait to see it come to life in the months ahead.

Like Kalo Yoghurt, we're keeping things silky smooth on the road

And that's not all, signature trailers for Linfox and Tegel have also been completed, fitted with a Carrier Vector HE 19 MT refrigeration unit. These high-spec builds are designed to go the distance, delivering reliability, performance, and maximum cooling efficiency, no matter the load.

Every detail matters, and none of this would be possible without the Fairfax team behind the scenes, from fabrication and fitout to finishing touches. Whether it's bold and branded or sleek and specialised, our trailers continue to set the bar for what's possible in transport.
